## *A. Consultancy, Team lead & Project management:*

### **Current situation**

Nowadays I work as free-lance technical consultant for Vanwezel Autoparts (<http://www.vanwezel.be/index.html>) since February 2020.

Job description: Application Engineer (*Technical Analyst and developer*) on IBM i on the core back-end systems in the logistics and WMS domain.

#### *Activities:*

Analysis, programming (Full Free RPG & RPG IV, CLLE), implementation, user education and -support and maintenance of several ERP and WMS projects.

### **Former consultancy activities:**

I'm self-employed since January 2015. Between early 2015 and early 2020 I was subcontracted by Harvey Nash (<https://www.harveynash.be>) via Talent-IT (<http://www.talent-it.be/en>) and Elmos NV (<http://www.elmos.be>).

For both agencies I was subcontracted respectively Colruyt Solucious (<https://www.solucious.be>) by Harvey Nash and to Belfius insurances by Elmos NV (<https://www.belfius.be/retail/nl/producten/verzekeringen/index.aspx>).

Before my self-employed activities I was employed by several companies in Belgium.

Since february1998 I basically worked as *consultant, project manager & Team lead* for **Iptor Supply Chain Systems** (former IBS) Belgium.

I started at IBS (formerly Proget nv) in 1998 as technical consultant. The main tasks in this function were analysis and programming tasks related to the financial package AFS400.

Since 2000 I moved to the Technology & Services department (at that time called 1S) and I did many Websphere, integration and Webfacing projects. In 2010 this department was renamed into Iptor.

At that time I also started to work as instructor for IBM (*see further*) via IBS.

Since 2002 I gradually moved from technical into business consultant where most of the time I was involved into the CRM business. Many presales and consultancy assignments were part of my day to day occupations.

## ***Curriculum Vitae***

Since 2008 my occupations shifted gradually from business consultant into project management. Every now and then I still took care of trainings for IBM.

Since the departure of the business unit manager of the software department of Iptor Belgium in June 2010, I got the opportunity to take over his tasks.

On February 1, 2012 I was asked officially to take over the responsibility of the department and became responsible for the software delivery of Iptor Benelux. In that role I managed 16 collaborators.

As of February 2013 I became responsible for the IBS WMS team. From than on I had a double role, i.e. team lead and project manager. My team implemented the WMS Dynamax. Our activities were spread from Sweden to South-Africa (EMEA). In my department I managed 7 collaborators.

### a. Free-lance instructor
